

THE PROJECT

RENFORESAP project is a multi-stakeholder and transnational approach amongst protected area managers of French Guiana. Suriname and Guyana. The project runs for three years

(2018-2020) with the aim to strengthen the resilience of the forest and the livelihoods of the local populations in a context of increasing impacts of global change on the Guiana Shield ecosystems. Its overall objective is to reinforce the capacity of protected or conservation area management in order to meet the common challenges they face.

RENFORESAP is in continuum with regional initiatives like Guiana Shield Facility (GSF), integration of protected areas of the Amazon Basin (EU project IAPA), networking of protected areas in South America (REDPARQUES) and mobilisation of protected areas and carbon finance (REDD +) in national and regional strategies for climate change.


THE ACTIONS FORESEEN

THE PARTNERS

RENFORESAP is carried out by the French Guiana Amazonian Park, the Protected Areas Commission of Guyana and the Ministries of Regional Development and Spatial planning, Land and Forest Management of Suriname. It also benefits from the support of international organisations of nature conservation working in the region.









FUNDING

The project is 74% funded by the Interreg Amazon Cooperation Programme (IACP) which is involved in the integrated development of French Guiana and its neighbouring Guiana Shield territories - Suriname, Guyana, Amapá, Pará and Amazonas.




